Bles-sed are they that search out His test-i-mo-nies; with their whole heart shall they seek af-ter Him.



For they that work in i - qui - ty have not walked in His ways.


Thy com - mand - ments

Would that my ways were di - rec - ted to keep Thy sta - tutes.




Then shall I not be a-shamed, when I look on all Thy com-mand-ments.




I will con-fess Thee with up-right-ness of heart, when I have learned the judg-ments of Thy right-eous-ness.
