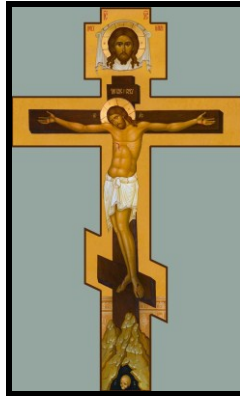

Holy Apostles Orthodox Church invites you to a pilgrimage to our mission, to begin to work on the beautiful historic building that has been donated to our parish. The pilgrimage schedule includes:

October 18th and 19th (Thursday and Friday), during daylight hours

Volunteers in Mission (VIM), led by Archpriest John Moses, will lead two work days at the historic church, in order to prepare the church for the upcoming Cross Procession.

October 20th (Saturday)

1:30 PM – Cross Procession. We will process from the current location of Holy Apostles in the office park, to the historic church, about a two-mile walk. The procession will be led by the cross, and people will also carry icons. The procession will be a physical expression of our prayer to the Lord that He move our parish to our new home, the beautiful historic St. Joseph's chapel on two acres of land in Beltsville. We hope to have a police escort for the procession.

3:00 PM – Prayer Service (moleben) and tour of the church. After this we will carpool back to the current church and share light refreshments, along with a discussion of what is needed in order for our parish to be able to move to the new location.

5:00 PM – Evening Vigil – 20th Sunday after Pentecost and the Fathers of the Seventh Ecumenical Council

October 21st (Sunday)

9:40 AM – Hours and Divine Liturgy, followed by an agape meal.
